

Seamless Systems: *Semi-Annual* Deep Cleaning Maintenance Instructions



NOTE: It is important to routinely remove dirt and grit from your seamless floor! If allowed to build-up, dirt, grit and grime will dull the look of the floor and make long-term maintenance more difficult, as well as affect the performance of the floor. It is recommended that you follow these instructions on a SEMI-ANNUAL basis to ensure optimum performance of your floor.

SUGGESTED MATERIALS:

- ★ Cotton Dust Mop
- ★ Pulastic Basic Clean
- ★ Wet Mop
- ★ Floor Buffer
- ★ Bleach Free Soft Scrub
- ★ Wet Vacuum



SEMI-ANNUAL CLEANING PROCEDURES:

STEP ONE: Sweep entire floor with a clean, untreated cotton dust mop to remove dirt and grit.



STEP TWO: Mix Basic Clean with hot tap water (approx 120°-130°) using a 200 to 1 water-to-cleaner ratio and pour into mop bucket. If the floor is extremely dirty, a 30:1 ratio for the hot tap water and Basic Clean can be used. Generously apply the water and cleaner solution to a 10x10 foot area and allow the solution to stand on the floor for 10 minutes to release and loosen dirt (emulsify).

Do not allow cleaner solution to dry on the floor or streaks will appear!



STEP THREE: While waiting for the water and cleaner solution to emulsify, prepare the floor buffer by attaching a Green Scrub Pad to the bottom of the buffer (for more assistance in buffer setup, refer to the equipment manufacturer's instruction manual).

STEP FOUR: After allowing the cleaner solution to rest for 10 minutes,

turn the floor buffer on and begin to buff the 10'x10' wet area until thoroughly buffed and clean. For floors that are harder to clean, apply a generous amount of bleach free Soft Scrub cleaner. Resume buffing until floor is thoroughly cleaned.

STEP FIVE: After the 10'x10' section has been cleaned, immediately begin to vacuum the area with a wet vacuum. If streaks or pools of water remain on the floor, go back over the area with the wet vacuum to ensure all areas are dry. Repeat steps 4 and 5 until the entire floor has been fully cleaned.



STEP FIVE

Once complete, a "wet floor" sign should be placed on floor. Allow the floor to dry overnight.

NOTE: If water/cleaner solution dries on the floor prior to being vacuumed, colored streaks will appear. To prevent this from happening do not allow solution to dry on the floor before vacuuming. If this does occur, wet mop the streaked area and immediately vacuum it with a wet vacuum.
